Skiing skill levels

1. Beginner, I have never skied before.
2. I can ski a little but I have never ridden a lift, and can neither stop or turn.
3. I can make wedge turns in both directions.
4. I can make rhythmical skidded turns and I can ride the Beginner Chair.
5. I can match my skis through out the last half of my turn.
6. I am developing my parallel turn and am exploring all intermediate terrain.
7. I can keep my skis parallel throughout the entire turn.
8. I can ski most anywhere with parallel turns that are dynamic and consistent.
9. I am an excellent parallel skier and can ski on varied terrain and varied snow conditions.

Snowboarding skill levels

1. Beginner, I have never ridden before.
2. I can maneuver with one foot and can slip on heel-side and toe-side.
3. I can perform a skidded traverse on both heel-side and toe-side edges and can stop.
4. I can perform elementary turns and heel-side and toe-side.
5. I can readily link turns and control speed by turning.
6. I can perform linked, skidded turns in varying size with good control on more challenging terrain.
7. I am beginning to carve turns and am comfortable on all intermediate terrain.
8. I am fine tuning carves of various size and can ride various terrain.
9. I can ride all terrain comfortably and want to explore the extremes of riding.

~ Release of Liability ~

I agree to enroll the afore-named student in the program ("Program"). I understand the student's participation in the Program involves exposure to the inherent risks of skiing and/or snowboarding, including, but not limited to, the terrain park, that cannot be eliminated. I recognize that there will be teaching on trails and terrain parks that have variations in terrain, man-made objects, other obstacles, and hazards including other skiers/snowboarders, which exist throughout the ski area. Terrain Park features and airborne maneuvers increase these risks. I freely accept and fully assume on my own and my child's behalf all risks, dangers and hazards associated with the use of the ski area's trails and terrain parks and the resulting possibility of personal injury or death.

I also understand that the student's participation in the Program may require the use of ski lifts and that the student may ride lifts alone, with other guests or with other children and that the use of lifts by the student involves a potential risk of injury. In consideration of the student's participation, individually and as the parent or guardian of the student, I HEREBY EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS associated with the student's participation in the Program including all risks associated with skiing and/or snowboarding, riding lifts or renting equipment.

Acknowledging the foregoing risks I, individually and as the parent or legal guardian of this student, AGREE NOT TO SUE AND TO RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS PATS PEAK SKIING, LLC, and its representatives, owners, employees and agents for any damage or injury arising out of the student's participation in the Program regardless of the cause, including NEGLIGENCE, that is, the failure to use reasonable care in any way.

In case of malfunction of the student's equipment, I authorize PATS PEAK employees to repair it as necessary or replace with PATS PEAK equipment if required so that the student may continue participation in the Program.

I understand that the foregoing is a LIABILITY RELEASE and that is legally binding on me, the student, our heirs and our legal representatives and I sign it of my own free will. I acknowledge that the foregoing is binding during the current ski season. This agreement is governed by the applicable law of New Hampshire. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THIS LIABILITY RELEASE.

Parent/Guardian: I verify that I am the parent or guardian of the minor, and I have authority to enter into this agreement on behalf of myself, my spouse and the participant and I agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of this release. **I understand that there are no individual make-ups or refunds on the program or rental equipment in the event that the student cancels or fails to attend for any reason whatsoever. I further acknowledge that Pats Peak has no obligation to provide a refund or a make-up in the event of closure or cancellation due to weather, snow conditions, or any other reason beyond its reasonable control.**

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

3-Day School Vacation Camps

- 1) Children's Programs meet at The Bear's Den, located in the building behind the Snowsports School Meeting Area.
- 2) Sessions run from 9:30am sharp to 3:30pm with an hour for lunch. We strongly recommend arriving at least 30 minutes early before your first session of the day (*arrive by 9:00 am*) to allow adequate time for your child to sign in, get ready for the slopes and meet their instructors.
- 3) Children are expected to ski/ride at 9:30am. Sorry, If the child is unable to be here on time he/she cannot join the group until the afternoon session.
- 4) If you chose to free ski with your child, please keep in mind he/she may not return to the group until the beginning of the next session. (*ie: afternoon session or the next day.*)
- 5) Children must be picked up at "Bear's Den" at 3:30pm.
