In 1962, Pats Peak opened and the Patenaudes began carving a skiing legacy out of a Heniker hillside. Skiing was something the family wanted to see grow in its hometown. Wayne and Sally Patenaude worked alongside many family and friends to craft this special spot. Forty five years later, Pats Peak holds status as the largest and longest locally owned facility in all of Northern New England.

A simple rope tow and T-bars took folks to the top then. Today it's chairlifts and carpet lifts. What never changes at Pats Peak are traditions of fun, family, and sharing a passion for skiing and riding. We still have our original learners' area, complete with two lifts and 100% snowmaking, and it's open free to the public.

Skiers are born

Right from the start, the Pats Peak ski school started to teach area children, and now tens of thousands of people have learned under our care. Those who catch the bug bring their love to lifts everywhere. Our skiers come back at every chance to get in a few runs and see friends in the Sled Pub.

In 1998 the New Hampshire legislature made skiing the official state sport. The bill was passionately sponsored by cousin and State Senator Amy Patenaude. Amy was part of the early days at Pats Peak, and she still races here every Tuesday night.

Weekends at the Peak for kids mean the Bear's Club and other fun learning for life programs from the Pats Peak Ski School. The Adult Clinics and Women Only Wednesdays inspire fitness,

fresh air, and fun. The POP program opens the doors to skiers and riders of all abilities with a Pay-One-Price on Saturday nights. It's an all access ticket to everything the Peak has to offer - and nothing short of a great party to come back to all winter long.

Racers are made

Our early investment in snowmaking set the pace for a racing legacy: In 1974, the United States Slalom Championships were moved to our slopes when no other resort in the East could produce snow to host the races. Every winter, the NASTAR Adult Corporate Racing program keeps the spirit alive on the slopes and après ski in the pub four nights a week.

Even if you don't race, come join us for great night skiing and riding. Pats 100% snowmaking and grooming makes every run a good one, on classic trails, woodland runs, and the terrain park. Get a bowl of free popcorn at the pub, and share a big M&M cookie from the kitchen with a friend.

And friends and families have fun

Kids 6 to 18 whose families are part of Pats Peak Ski Club are living a tradition since the early winter dinners of spaghetti and hot chocolate. Many kids in the program today have parents who were once young members of the club themselves, twenty five years ago or more. Every year at the Childhood Cancer Lifeline, we celebrate children, life, and the sport.
